# ACADEMICS

## CYCLONE SMART

### Market Savvy Academics

New academic programs launched during the 2019-2020 academic year in medical lab science and health science—plus a 2+2 education degree offered with Raritan Valley Community College—ensure that Centenary continues to meet emerging needs of students and the job market. Next up: a new exercise science major, slated to launch in 2021.

In addition, a new career-focused core curriculum debuted in September.



### Tech on Tap

Investments in classroom technology paved the way for new and creative teaching modalities like HyFlex learning combining on-ground and online instruction and flipped classrooms emphasizing independent learning. The result: more personalized education based on students' individual learning styles.

## **Move Over, Harvard!**

Centenary University student-researchers took four of the top 10 spots—including first and second places—for their presentations at an international conference, besting more than 750 entries from research powerhouses like Harvard, Yale, Stanford, and Johns Hopkins.





## New Digs

The Cyclones played their first game on Our Diamond of Dreams—the University’s new baseball complex, just weeks before the pandemic hit. Located on campus, the facility is the result of a generous lead gift from Stephen HA’19 and Sharon Somers, as well as a host of other donors. The Cyclones are hoping to take the field in spring 2021.

**We’ve invested in Centenary University’s athletic and extracurricular programs, as well as enhanced on-campus safety measures. The result: a richer, safer Cyclone experience.**

## Safety First

Increased donor contributions last year paved the way for the University to introduce a host of measures to enhance student safety, such as on-campus rapid response COVID-19 testing, upgrades to the dining and residence halls for greater social distancing, and the installation of plexiglass barriers and hand sanitizing stations. Bonus: all students received #CycloneStrong face masks.



## Outside the Box

Student Life and the Centenary Stage Company took to the great outdoors with a full slate of new events as the campus slowly began to reopen. Activities, including outdoor movies, virtual scavenger hunts, and theatre productions on the front steps of the Edward W. Seay Administration Building, were the result of extensive planning on the part of Centenary staffers as the 2019-2020 academic year came to a close.

## Centenary Choice

Intensive planning as the academic year drew to a close laid the groundwork for successful fall recruitment. Popular perk: Centenary Choice, a program developed in response to the pandemic that allows students to customize their classroom experience by choosing to attend in person, online, or in a HyFlex format combining in-person and online learning.

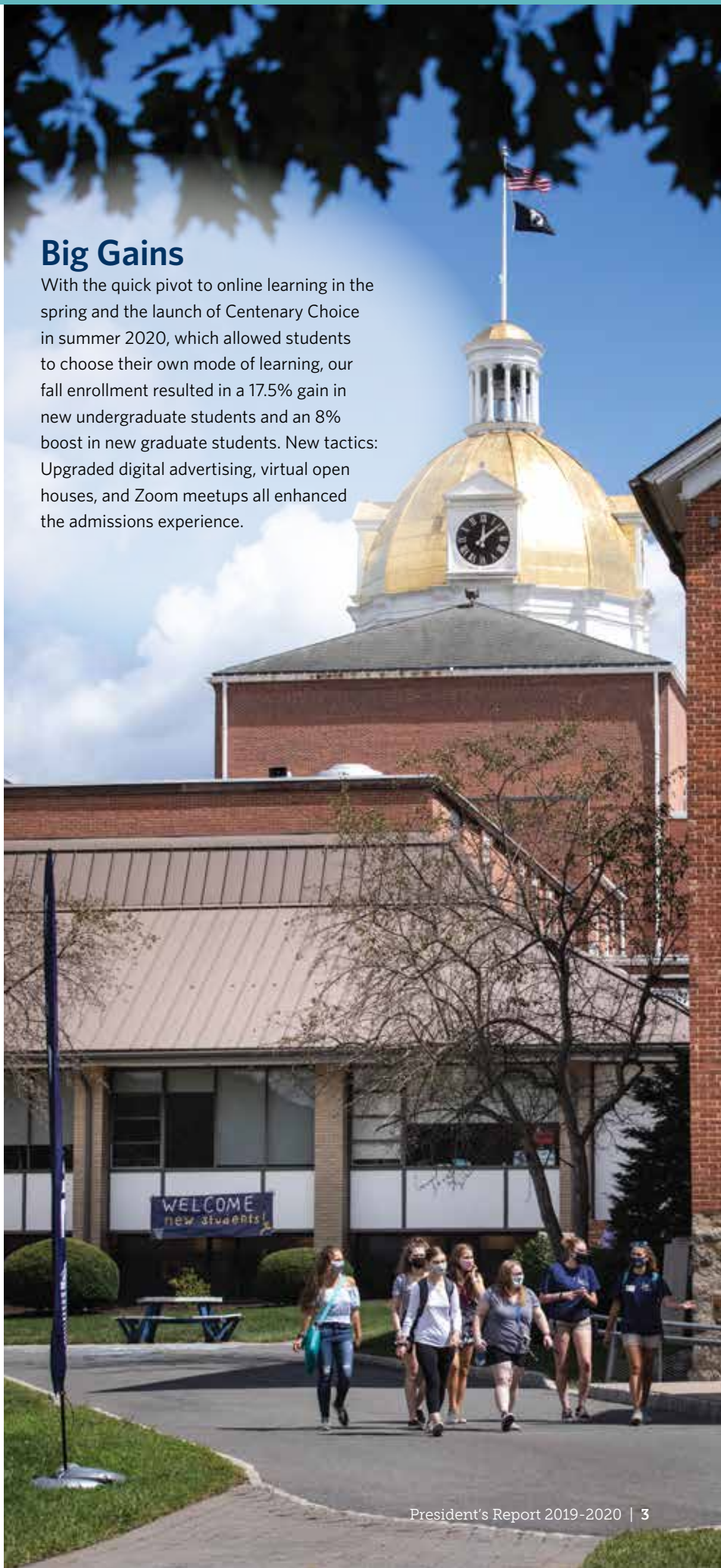


## National Rankings

Five prestigious listings of top colleges and universities recognized Centenary University: Top Performer on Social Mobility (US News & World Report—Regional Universities North), Top Six New Jersey University (WalletHub), Top 3 MBA Program in New Jersey (NJBIZ), Top 50 Best Online Business Program in the Nation (Study.com), and Top 50 MLPA Program in the Nation (Intelligent.com).

## Big Gains

With the quick pivot to online learning in the spring and the launch of Centenary Choice in summer 2020, which allowed students to choose their own mode of learning, our fall enrollment resulted in a 17.5% gain in new undergraduate students and an 8% boost in new graduate students. New tactics: Upgraded digital advertising, virtual open houses, and Zoom meetups all enhanced the admissions experience.

## Generosity Grows

## Endowing the Future

New endowed scholarships honor the legacies of two late Centenary graduates, Louise M. Monez Hill '40 and Marilyn Lewis Jenkins '51. Hill was a longtime teacher whose generous bequest has established diversity-based scholarships at Centenary. Jenkins was a Navy wife whose son, former CDR John S. Jenkins, Jr., JAGC, USN, stepped up to establish a scholarship in his mother's name to assist active duty or retired service personnel afford a Centenary University education.
